

Transient Student 101

A student may take up to 18 credit hours as a transient student if they are seeking a Bachelor's degree and 9 credit hours if they are seeking an Associate of Arts degree.

1. You need to be in good standing with the college, and this means that your overall GPA should be in line with the number of credits hours calculated:

Credit Hours Minimum Required Calculated Cumulative GPA

Hours	GPA
0 – 30	1.5
31 – 60	1.7
61 – 90	1.9
91 -	2.0

2. Determine the college or university you wish to attend, and with your advisor, determine the courses you need to take. **The courses must apply to your degree plan.**

3. Apply online at <http://www.bpc.edu/registrar/registrar.htm> using the transient permission form, and choose the Online Submission link.

4. Complete all the information in the form (institute's name, contact person if you have one, address, course name and number, etc.).

5. You will need to apply to the college and meet their standards of admission.

6. Once you receive final grades, you will need to request official transcripts be sent to our office and the address is:
